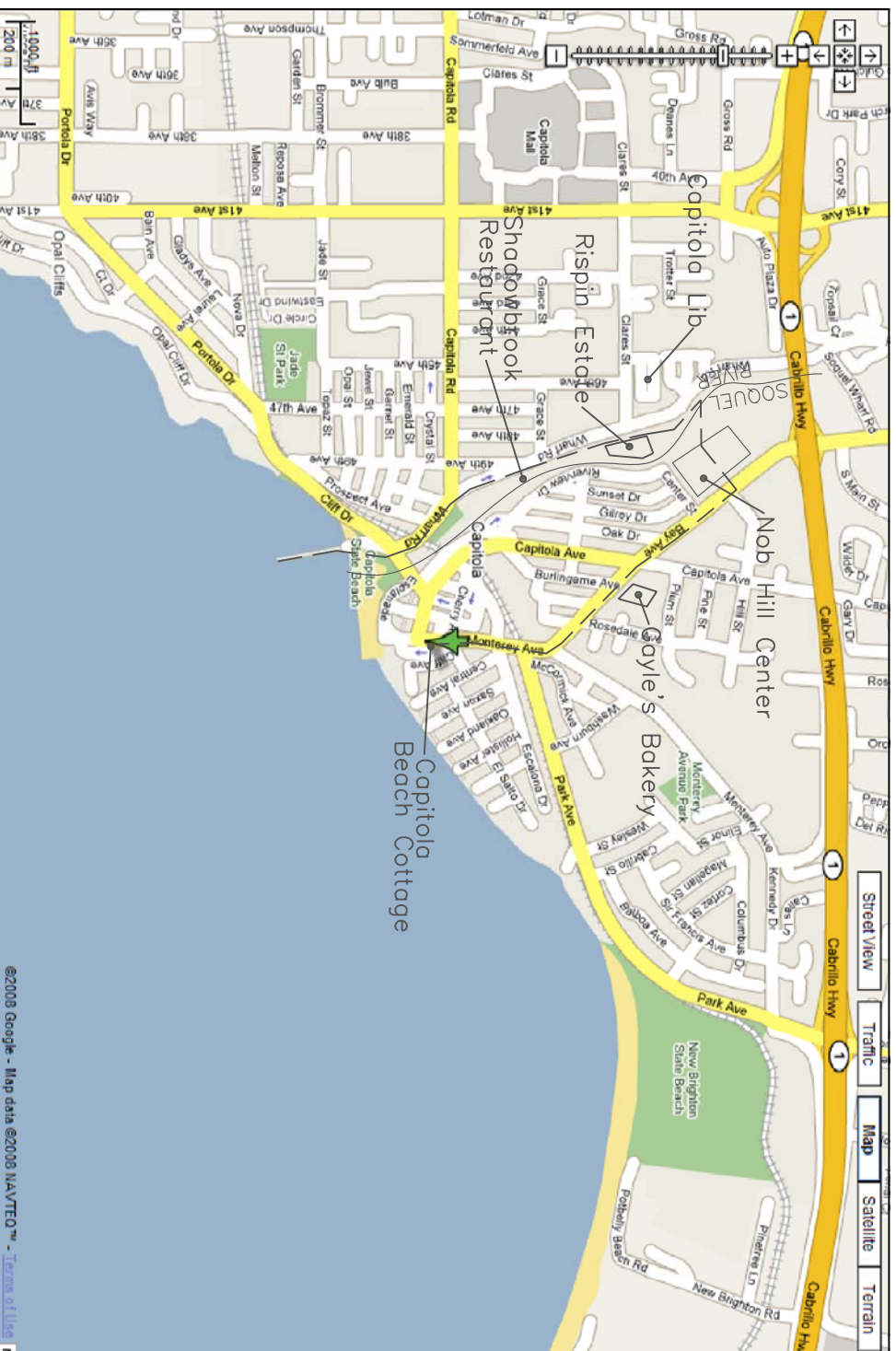
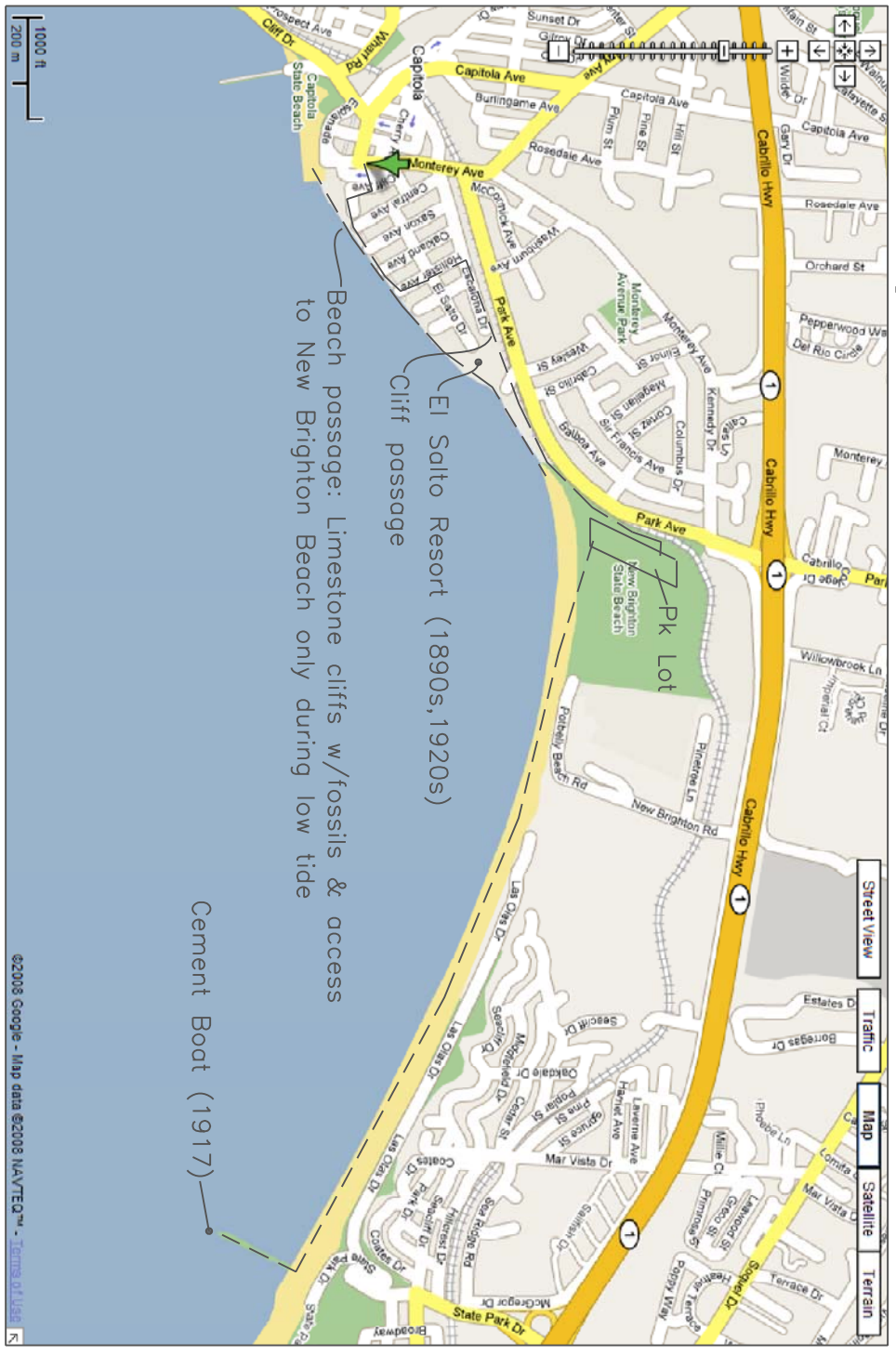


Capitola Historic Walk #1 – 1.5Mi Cottage–Rispin Estate–Wharf Loop



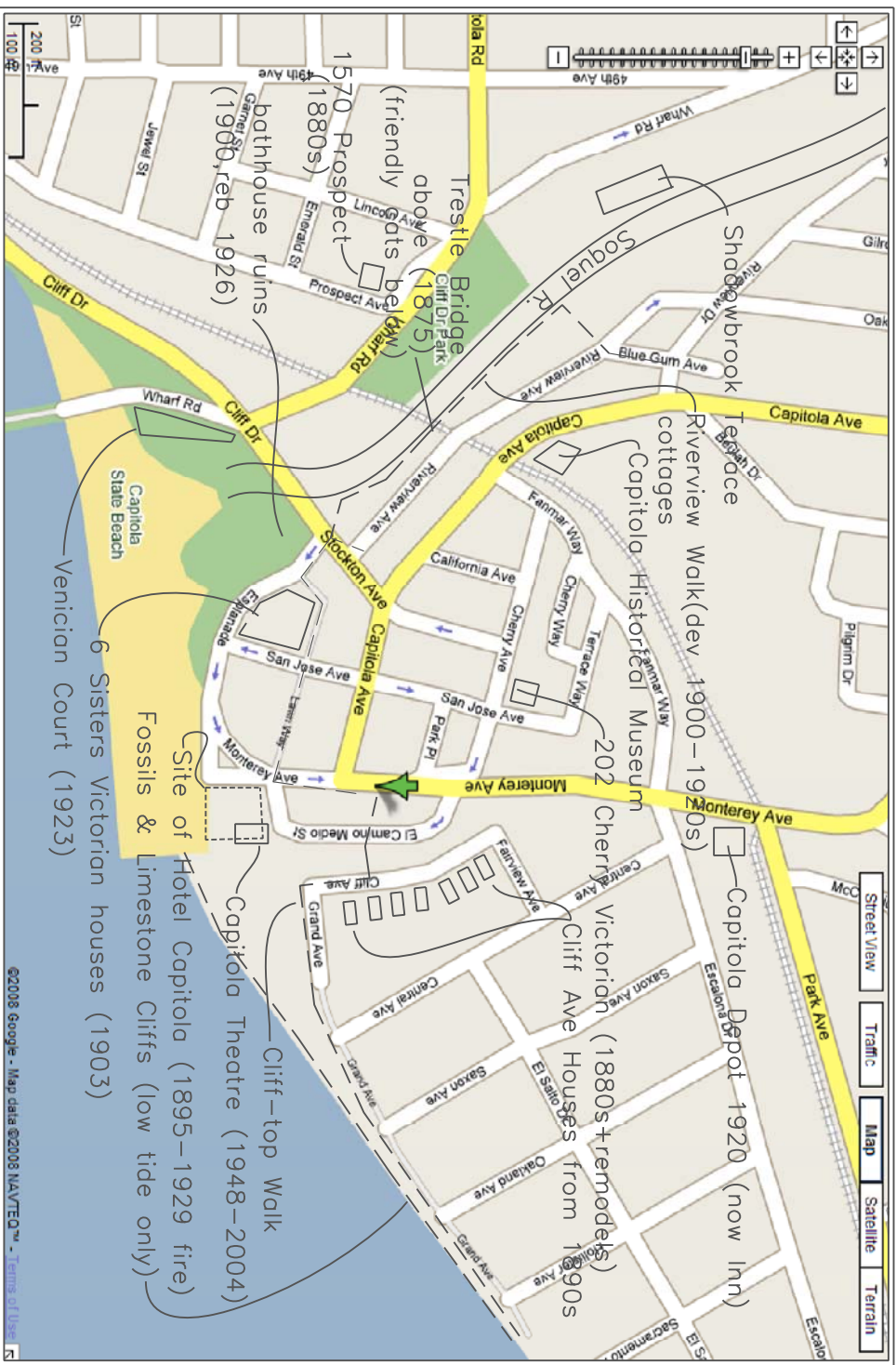
- Start from the Beach Cottage (1929), walk up Monterey, veering left to Boy
- for a walking snack, stop by Goyle’s for one of their bakery or sandwich offerings
- Walking into the Nob Hill Shopping center, continue to the furthest rear of parking lot
- Look for footpath and sign, heading towards sequel creek
- Follow footpath over Sequel River, and up hill. Look for Rispin Mansion (1922) on left
- the smallest Capitola public library is across Wharf Rd if you need beach reading
- for a cheap thrill, ride the Shadowbrook Restaurant (1907) trolley down the hill and walk around (for a more expensive thrill, stop and eat :–)
- Continuing down Wharf, walk through the Venician Court (1923) and alleys
- Take the stairs up to the Capitola wharf (1856), and stroll around.

Capitola Historic Walk #2 – 5Mi (round trip) Cottage to Cement Boat Wreck



- Start from the beach cottage (1929), walk behind the ice cream shop/toquerio and head up the long stairs to Cliff Rd
- follow the cliff-top walkway, which ends just beyond Hollister.
- head down Hollister and Right on Escalona, staying on the path to the left (for an interesting side trip, take an early right on El Salto to El Salto Resort-1890s)
- watch your footing through the foliage, then follow the RR tracks South look to the right after the first driveway you cross for the resumption of the bluff trail
- Look right for the Seaciff parking lot (wait for later easy trail down), from parking lot, take the stairs down to the beach
- follow the beach to the pier & Cement Boat, which was intentionally run aground in 1917 to become an entertainment center with dining, dancing, bar, and swimming pool, lasting 2 years.
- Note: during low tide, you can time short dashes between waves and cross below the cliffs – try this when the tide is low enough that you're not on the slippery rocks! admire the limestone fossils along the way – but don't remove any!
- it's just a walk along the beach the entire way after that :-)

Capitola Riverview & Cliff Walks #3



- Cliff-top Walk:**
- Start from the Beach Cottage, walk behind the ice cream shop/toqueria and head up the long stairs to Cliff Rd
 - follow the cliff-top walkway, which ends just beyond Hollister Ave.
- Riverview Walk:**
- Start from the Beach Cottage, walk down historic Lawn Way (guest tents in 1920) cross by Margaritaville to Riverview walkway
 - At end of riverfront walkway, loop back via Riverview or Capitola.
- Note:** during low tide, you can time short dashes between waves and cross below the cliffs - try this when the tide is low enough that you're not on the slippery rocks! admire the limestone fossils along the way - but don't remove any!
